## RESOLUTION NO. 100548

Approving and endorsing Gee Whiz Holdings, LLC in their application for state remediation tax credits to the Missouri Department of Economic Development Brownfields Redevelopment Program, as authorized by, and in accordance with section 447.700(1) of the Revised Statutes of Missouri.
