TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

REGULATION NUMBERS 58404 THROUGH 58412 REMOVALS

May 5, 2005

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (b) of Section 70.38 of the "Code of General Ordinances of Kansas City, Missouri" and subject to the provisions thereof, traffic regulations are hereby made and adopted as follows:

The **Maximum Speed Limit**, as indicated below and as listed in **Section 70-363**, is hereby discontinued at the following location:

Regulation 58404 North Bennington Avenue from Northeast Russell Road to Northeast 48th Street Twenty-Five Miles Per Hour

Prohibition of **Stopping, Standing and/or Parking**, as indicated below and as listed in **Section 70-530**, is hereby discontinued at the following locations:

Regulation 58405 Wyandotte Street, east side, from a point 440 feet south of 141st Terrace then south 214 feet No Parking Anytime

Reserved Parking for **Handicapped Individuals**, as indicated below and as listed in **Section 70-534 and 70-535** is hereby discontinued at the following locations:

Regulation 58406 8th Street, south side, from a point 95 feet west of Denver Avenue then west 25 feet Handicapped Parking

Regulation 58407 9th Street, south side, from a point 345 feet east of Benton Boulevard then east 35 feet Handicapped Parking

Regulation 58408 Oakley Avenue, west side, from a point 180 feet south of St. John Avenue then south 25 feet Handicapped Parking

Regulation 58409 Oakley Avenue, east side, from a point 246 feet south of St. John Avenue then south 25 feet Handicapped Parking

The **Loading Zone**, as indicated below and as listed in **Section 70-561** is hereby discontinued at the following location:

Regulation 58410 Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 28 feet north of 10th Street then north 61 feet No Parking Loading Zone 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM

Regulation 58411 Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 163 feet north of 10th Street then north 26 feet No Parking Loading Zone 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM

Regulation 58412 Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 205 feet north of 10th Street then north 26 feet No Parking Loading Zone 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM

The existing signs at the locations affected by the above regulations will be removed.

REGULATION NUMBERS 58413 THROUGH 58428 INSTALLATIONS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (b) of Section 70.38 of the "Code of General Ordinances of Kansas City, Missouri" and subject to the provisions thereof, traffic regulations are hereby made and adopted as follows:

All vehicular traffic shall **Stop** before entering the following intersections and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-335**:

Regulation 58413 North Robinhood Avenue and Northwest 85th Terrace Eastbound

Regulation 58414 North Robinhood Avenue and Northwest 86th Street Westbound

Regulation 58415 North Robinhood Avenue and Northwest 86th Court Eastbound

Regulation 58416 North Robinhood Avenue and

Northwest 87th Street Northbound

Regulation 58417 North Robinhood Avenue and North
Ava Avenue Eastbound

Regulation 58418 Agnes Avenue and 21st Street
Southbound

Regulation 58419 North Charlotte Street and Northeast
119th Street Eastbound and Westbound

Regulation 58420 North Jefferson Street and Northwest
52nd Terrace Eastbound and Westbound

Regulation 58421 North Poplar Avenue and Northeast
78th Street Northbound

The driver of a vehicle shall **Yield the Right-of-Way** to all vehicles approaching the following intersections, in the direction bound as indicated, when **Yields** are in place and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-335**:

Regulation 58422 North Fuller Avenue and Northeast
44th Terrace Southbound

Regulation 58423 North Wyandotte Street and
Northwest 113th Terrace Eastbound and Westbound

Stopping, Standing and/or Parking shall be prohibited, as indicated, on the following streets and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-530**:

Regulation 58424 Wyandotte Street, east side, from M-150 Highway right of way south 1730 feet to the state line No Parking Anytime

Motorized Bike Parking is designated at the following location, and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-539**:

Regulation 58425 Westport Road, north side, from a point 50 feet west of Pennsylvania Avenue then west 50 feet Motorized Bike Parking

A **Loading Zone** is designated at the following locations, and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-561**:

Regulation 58426 Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 28 feet north of 10th Street then north 61 feet No Parking Loading Zone

Regulation 58427 Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 163 feet north of 10th Street then north 26 feet No Parking Loading Zone

Regulation 58428 Baltimore Avenue, east side, from a point 205 feet north of 10th Street then north 26 feet No Parking Loading Zone

The locations affected by the above regulations will be marked in accordance with standards prescribed in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Street and Highways" and said regulations shall become effective five days after publication in The Daily Record.
