- 2019 Pan American Youth Championships (Equador); and

WHEREAS, Emma Nye showing her wide range of talents participated in the 2018 and 2019 Missouri Regional and state Cheerleader championships while earning a high school letter in cheerleading; and

WHEREAS, Emma Nye, while competing at the highest level in her sports career maintained a 3.5 GPA that includes 21 college credits that will allow her to enter college as a sophomore; NOW, THEREFORE,

That the Mayor and Council hereby honor and congratulate Emma Nye for her numerous individual accomplishments as well as her accomplishments as a member of the Staley High School Cheerleading team; and
