Section 1. That the following funds be closed upon the City's books and any balances be transferred to the General Fund.

- 7140 Public Works Working Capital Fund

- 8910 Parking Garage (Auditorium Plaza) Fund

Section 2. That the following funds be closed upon the City's books and any balances be transferred to the Park Maintenance Fund.

- 7130 Parks and Recreation Working Capital Fund
- 6440 Union Cemetery Trust

Section 3. That the following funds be closed upon the City's books and any balances be transferred to the Capital Improvements Fund.

- 7070 Engineering Services (CIMO) Fund
- 3810 KCMAC Leasehold Revenue Bonds Series 1990
- 3880 KCMAC Leasehold Revenue Bonds Series 1991
- 3990 KCMAC Leasehold Revenue Bonds Series 1993A
