

ORDINANCE NO. 100652

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Gladstone for improvements to N. Broadway, from Gladstone city limits north approximately 250 feet and authorizing expenditure, with required approvals, from funds previously appropriated in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00.

WHEREAS, North Broadway serves as a major north-south collector running parallel to U.S. 169 and North Oak; and

WHEREAS, North Broadway is improved in Gladstone with curbs and gutters, sidewalks, and streetlights, except for the north end of the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the unimproved section at the north end of Gladstone is narrow, winding, and hilly and has a history of accidents; and

WHEREAS, Gladstone cannot improve this section of street without improving North Broadway within Kansas City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gladstone has developed plans for construction of the aforementioned improvements; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2010, the voters in the City of Gladstone approved issuance of bonds to fund their portion of the improvements to North Broadway; and

WHEREAS, the Cities wish to cause the construction of this improvement upon the completion of right of way acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the improvements cannot happen without a \$125,000.00 contribution from Kansas City to improve North Broadway within the city limits of Kansas City; and

WHEREAS, the Second Council District committed \$100,000.00 in FY 2010 and \$25,000.00 in FY 2011 to extend the improvement approximately 250 feet into Kansas City; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to execute a public infrastructure funding agreement with the City of Gladstone for improvements to North Broadway.

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Section 2. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 subject to the receipt of all required approvals, from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 11-3090-898201-89008196-B for the financial obligations contained in the agreement. The agreement is approved in substantial form as that on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.

I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
