ORDINANCE NO. 190466

Authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to execute a \$350,000.00 contract with the County of Vernon, Missouri and its Sheriff to house City inmates and detainees; and authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to amend and extend the contract with such additional funds that are appropriated for such purpose.

WHEREAS, since 2014, the City has housed City inmates and detainees and KCPD arrestees and detainees at the Jackson County Regional Correction Center under an Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement ("Agreement") with Jackson County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2018, Jackson County notified the City that Jackson County was terminating the Agreement on June 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County's termination of the Agreement has necessitated the City to have short-term and long-term transition plans to house City inmates and detainees and KCPD arrestees and detainees; and

WHEREAS, this contract with the County of Vernon and its Sheriff will provide a short-term housing solution for City inmates and detainees while the City develops long term solutions; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, the County of Vernon and its Sheriff will house at least 20 City inmates and detainees; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Manager of Procurement Services is authorized to execute a \$350,000.00 contract with the County of Vernon and its Sheriff to house City inmates and detainees with funds previously appropriated to Account No. 20-1000-272210-B-619080 for such purpose. A copy of the contract in substantial form is on file in office of the Manager of Procurement Services.

Section 2. That the Manager of Procurement Services is authorized to amend and extend the contract with such additional funds that are appropriated for such purpose without additional City Council authorization.
