

RESOLUTION NO. 080641

Honoring Mohsin Zaidi on his retirement from the City after 21 years 4 months of service.

WHEREAS, Mohsin Zaidi has announced his retirement from the City of Kansas City, Missouri, effective June 31, 2008, having served twenty-one years and four months; and

WHEREAS, Mohsin was raised in Pakistan and worked in Pakistan, Bangladesh, and Saudi Arabia before immigrating to the United States; and

WHEREAS, Mohsin is married to Nina and has two children and one grandchild; and

WHEREAS, Mohsin attended Oklahoma University and obtained a Master's degree in civil engineering and worked for Vollmer Associates, and later for Association of Central Oklahoma Governments before arriving in Kansas City; and

WHEREAS, on April 20, 1987, Mohsin began his long and distinguished career with the Transportation Department and later with Public Works/Streets and Traffic Division at City Hall, and has spent all of his career with the City of Kansas City, Missouri, at this location and in this department and division; and

WHEREAS, during this time, he has worked on many projects, including, but not limited to, the Impact Fee Ordinance, Downtown Traffic Signal Coordination, most of the signal and roadway improvement projects handled by Public Works/Engineering and represented Kansas City as a member of several national committees including but not limited to the 2009 Update of Manual of Uniform Traffic Devices, Roundabout Design, and the 2008 National Conference on Roundabouts; and

WHEREAS, Mohsin will be moving to Commonwealth of Virginia to work with Virginia Department of Transportation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI:

That the Mayor and Council hereby honor Mohsin Zaidi on his retirement from the City after 21 years 4 months of service; and
