Reason for Legislation  The City was ordered to place two sales taxes on the November ballot in <i>City v. Chastain</i> , Case No. 1116-CV29139. This ordinance authorizes the City Clerk to send the required notices to the election authorities. The deadline to send the notices is August 26, 2014. Voters will be asked to approve a ½ percent sales tax for capital improvements and a 1/8 percent sales tax for transportation purposes. Discussion (including relationship to other Council actions)  In 2011, a committee of petitioners submitted an initiative petition seeking the adoption of two sales taxes by the voters, which also included proposed ballot language indicating that the revenue would be used to fund specific transportation improvements. The City Council declined to pass the ordinance after determining it was an unconstitutional appropriation ordinance because it failed to provide all of the revenue needed to fund the transportation improvements described in the ordinance.  After the Circuit Court and Court of Appeals held that the ordinance was an unconstitutional appropriation ordinance, the committee of petitioners sought transfer to the Missouri Supreme Court, and the court granted transfer.
