Council previously passed Ord. 120942 (sub.), authorizing the City, EDC and EDC Loan Corporation to execute a Downtown Housing Financial Assistance Agreement, in which the City pledged \$2,000,000 to support downtown housing to a developer to be selected through a competitive process. RMW Apartments responded to a Request For Proposals, proposing to construct a 137-unit, market-rate, new construction rental apartment building to be located at 228 W. 4th Street. The EDC proposes to loan RMW Apartments \$2,000,000 for construction of the apartments through the Development Agreement. This ordinance approves the Development Agreement between RMW Apartments and the EDC; such approval is a condition of the Downtown Housing Financial Assistance Agreement. City staff has participated in the negotiation of the Development Agreement, which contains such terms as are required by the terms of the Financial Assistance Agreement.
