### Details

#### Reason for Legislation

Amending Chapter 64, Code of Ordinances, by adding a new Section 64-169 entitled Bicycle Rack Permit authorizing the Director of Public Works to regulate and permit use of bicycle racks within public sidewalks; amending Chapter 18, Code of Ordinances, by repealing Section 18-25, and enacting in lieu thereof a new section of like designation and subject matter to include bicycle racks as an exception to the encroachment permitting process.

#### Discussion

Currently if a property owner wants to install a bike rack within the ROW at their property, they have to obtain an encroachment permit. Encroachment permit have to be renewed each year. The Bike Rack permit will stay in effect for the life of the rack and the associated one-time fee is less than the encroachment permit fees over the life of the rack. The permit language, requirements and fees have been reviewed by the Bike Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC). This change will make it easier for property owners to install bike racks at their properties in order to meet the demand of cyclists.
