Reason for Legislation

To accept a contract from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for Ryan White Part B HIV Medical Case Management for the period of 4/1/2016 to 3/31/17. The amount of the contract is \$825,000.00

Discussion

The purpose of this contract is to ensure that all residents living with HIV/AIDS within the 7 Missouri counties of the Kansas City Transitional Grant Area (Cass, Clay, Clinton, Jackson, Lafayette, Platte, and Ray) receive medical case management services according to the policies, procedures, and standards of practice outlined and published by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. In addition, training and education services are provided for HIV medical case managers in Buchanan County

The HIV Services program provides HIV/AIDS medical case management services over 2,400 unduplicated clients across the 11 county, bi-state region each year. Of these over 1,600 live in the MO counties cover by this contract. These services are provided by approximately 35 medical case managers from 4 different agencies (**Good Samaritan Project**, **Kansas City CARE Clinic**, **Truman Medical Center**, and the University of Kansas Hospital). The comprehensive system of care is monitored for the quality, programatic and fiscal integrity by the Kansas City Missouri Health Department, HIV Services Program.

Services under this Ryan White Part B contract will be provided by **Good Samaritan Project** [Transitional (Corrections) Case Management and Medical Case Management (MCM) services], **Truman Medical Center** [Medicaid Waiver-State Plan Personal Care Case Management and MCM services] and **KC CARE Clinic** [Resource and Referral Case Management services and Youth Case Management services].

Policy or Program

Is the contract good for the children?

Yes. These services are provided to mothers and children living with HIV/AIDS. During the 2014-15 program year, 6.5% of the case management clients served met the HRSA definitions for youth, infants, and/or children. In addition, 18.9% of the clients served were women. Clients served included 8 children (HIV+ and non-HIV+) under the age of 2 who received services along with their mothers. This award includes funding to support a Youth Case Manager who specifically works with children and youth who are HIV+.

How will this contribute to a sustainable Kansas City?

Quality health care directly impacts the economic vitality, social equity and environmental quality of a community. Promoting and protecting citizens of Kansas City is the goal for all public health programs. Individuals living with HIV/AIDS are required to enroll in Medical Case Management to access Ryan White medical services such as primary care, medications, oral health, mental health, substance abuse treatment services and insurance premium assistance. Funding for Medical Case Management ensures that residents living with HIV/AIDS within the Kansas City TGA receive appropriate health care services and treatment of their disease through federal, state and local funding resources.
