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ORDINANCE NO. 020029

Authorizing a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas for the maintenance of State Line Road and directing the City Clerk to file certain documents with the appropriate offices.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to enter into and execute, on behalf of the City of Kansas City, Missouri, a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas, for the maintenance of State Line Road, traffic signal devices, streetlights and drainage facilities from the centerline of West 50th Terrace to the south city limits of Westwood Hills, Kansas (maintenance area). A copy of the Cooperative Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That upon the effective date of this ordinance, the City Clerk is hereby directed to cause the ordinance and the attached Cooperative Agreement to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Jackson County, Missouri, and a copy thereof to be sent to the Missouri Secretary of State pursuant to Section 70.300, RSMo, 1978.



COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR MAINTENANCE OF STATE LINE ROAD

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 10th day of May, 2001, between Kansas City, Missouri, a constitutionally chartered municipal corporation of Missouri (Kansas City) and the City of Westwood Hills, Kansas (Westwood Hills), a municipality organized and existing under the laws of Kansas.

WHEREAS, the city limits of Kansas City and Westwood Hills abut along the Kansas/ Missouri state line (State Boundary) from the centerline of West 50th Terrace to the south City Limits of Westwood, Kansas (Maintenance area); and

WHEREAS, the State Line Road (Road) extends along most of the State Boundary, and extends into Kansas City and Westwood Hills; and

WHEREAS, the State Boundary line does not consistently coincide with the centerline of the Road as it extends through Kansas City and Westwood Hills but rather meanders east and west of the centerline and is even out of the traveled right of way at some locations; and

WHEREAS, the parties have determined that to maintain the portions of the Road, traffic control devices, street lights and drainage facilities located in their respective cities in the Maintenance Area without the collaboration and designation of responsibilities will be difficult, inefficient and costly; and

WHEREAS, the parties have determined that they can achieve continuous, consistent and timely maintenance and substantial savings by designating the responsibility for routine maintenance of the Road, traffic control devices, street lights and drainage facilities located in their respective cities in the Maintenance Area;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals, the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

Sec. 1. Statutory authority and scope. Pursuant to Section 70.210 et. seq., R.S. Mo., as amended, and K.S.A. 12-2901 et. seq., as amended, the parties enter into this Agreement to designate the responsibilities for the routine maintenance of the Road, traffic control devices, street lights and drainage facilities located in their respective cities. Upon the effective date of this Agreement, it shall be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Jackson County, Missouri, and an additional copy shall be sent to Secretary of State of Missouri, in compliance with Section 70.300 R.S.Mo. This Agreement, it shall also be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Johnson County, Kansas, and a copy shall be sent to the Attorney General of Kansas, in compliance with K.S.A. 12-2904. The recording costs for Jackson County, Missouri shall be paid by Kansas City. The recording costs for Johnson County, Kansas shall be paid by Westwood Hills.

Sec. 2. Definitions. For purposes of this Agreement, the following words shall have the designated meaning.

Drainage maintenance. Drainage maintenance shall mean cleaning and maintaining the drainage facilities and improvements open and in good repair.

Routine pavement repairs. "Routine pavement repairs" shall mean making pothole and full depth pavement repairs for the full width of the Road.

Routine Road maintenance. "Routine maintenance" shall mean sweeping the pavement, removal of litter, snow plowing, and chemical treatment of snow or ice for the full width of the Road.

Traffic control. "Traffic control" shall mean installation, maintenance and repair of traffic devices, signs, and pavement markings and timing of traffic signals.

Maintenance Area. "Maintenance Area" shall mean that portion of State Line Road located between the easterly prolongation of the centerline of West 50th Terrace and the easterly prolongation of the south city limit boundary line of Westwood at State Line Road.

Sec. 3. Administration and Designation of responsibilities. This Agreement shall be administered jointly by the parties' respective Public Works Directors or their designees. The parties agree that during the term of this Agreement that:

- A. Drainage maintenance. The maintenance of each catch basin and drop inlet in the Maintenance Area shall be performed by the city where the structure is located. Westwood Hills does not have catch basins, drop inlets or culverts in the Maintenance Area, but it shall maintain that portion, located in Westwood Hills, of the box culvert which originates in Westwood Hills near 50th Terrace and the Road and extends through Mission Woods and across the Road into Kansas City.
- B. Routine pavement repairs. Routine pavement repairs of the Road in the Maintenance Area shall be performed by Kansas City.
- C. Routine Road maintenance. Routine maintenance of the Road in the Maintenance Area shall be performed by Westwood Hills.
- D. Street Lights. Maintenance of each street light located along the Road in the Maintenance Area shall be performed by the city that owns or leases the light.

The cost of operating and maintaining the Street Lights shall be borne by the owner or lessor.

- E. Traffic Control. The installation and maintenance of the centerline, lane lines and cross walks in the Road in the Maintenance Area shall be performed by Kansas City. The installation and maintenance of traffic and parking control signs and street name signs for the Road in the Maintenance area shall be performed by Kansas City on the east side of State Line Road and by Westwood Hills on the west side of State Line Road.
- F. Curbs, gutters and sidewalks. The installation and maintenance of curbs, gutters and sidewalks in and along the Road in the Maintenance Area shall be performed by the respective city where the curb, gutter or sidewalk is located.
- G. Payment of Costs. Each party shall bear its respective costs herein out of funds lawfully available for the same, and keep accounts thereof.
- H. Retention of Property and Right-of-Way. Each party shall use and retain its respective property and right-of-way in furtherance hereof. No property or right-of-way shall be jointly acquired or owned by the parties hereto for the purposes herein.
- Sec. 4. Work performed by contractors. Work under this Agreement may be performed by the parties own employees or by a contractor, but no contract with a contractor shall be entered into without the approval of the other party.
- Sec. 5. Exclusions. Installation of future traffic signals and street lights as well as reconstruction, rehabilitation, resurfacing and other significant repairs to the pavement and drainage facilities are not covered by this Agreement.
- **Sec. 6. Cooperation.** The parties will consult and cooperate with each other as necessary to accomplish the purpose of this Agreement and, in particular, will coordinate the timing of traffic signals and will seek to have appropriate and uniform traffic regulations enacted to provide for the rapid, smooth and safe flow of traffic on State Line Road.
- Sec. 7. Duration and Termination. This Agreement shall remain effective until terminated as provided herein. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving ninety (90) days written notice of such termination to the other party.
- Sec. 8. Notices. Any notice in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing to the parties at the addresses shown below:

Sec. 9. Merger. This Agreement, including any referenced Attachments, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to this subject matter, and supersedes all prior agreements between the parties with respect to this subject matter, unless other wise provided herein.

Sec. 10. Modification.

- A. Unless stated otherwise in this Agreement, no provision of this Agreement may be waived, modified or amended except by written amendment signed by both parties.
- B. No act, conversation or communication with any officer, agent, or employee of either party, either before or after the execution of this Agreement, shall affect or modify any term or terminology of this Agreement and any such act, conversation, or communication shall not be binding upon either party.

Sec. 11. Severability of Provisions. Except as specifically provided in this Agreement, all of the provisions of this Agreement shall be severable. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or unlawful, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall be valid unless the court finds that the valid provisions of this Agreement are so essentially and inseparably connected with and so dependent upon the invalid provision(s) that it cannot be presumed that the parties to this Agreement could have included the valid provisions without the invalid provision(s); or unless the court finds that the valid provisions, standing alone, are incapable of being performed in accordance with the intentions of the parties.
