### Details

#### Reason for Legislation

In order to qualify for annual grants from the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development under the Community Development Block Grant, Home Investment Partnerships, Emergency Solutions Grant and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS programs, the City is required to submit a Five-Year Consolidated Plan and a One-Year Action Plan detailing how grant funds will be utilized to provide decent housing, suitable living environments and economic opportunity for its citizens.

The 5-Year Plan covering 2012-16 was approved in March 8, 2012 by Committee Substitute for Resolution No. 120159. The 2014 Action Plan will cover the third year of the Consolidated Plan. The Neighborhoods, Housing and Healthy Communities Committee heard public testimony on January 8<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> and March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

#### Discussion

The City is preparing to enter the third year of the 5-Year Consolidated Plan. The 2014 Action Plan indicates how grant funds in the third year will be used and the subrecipients and developers who will receive funding from the City. The amount of grant funds including reprogrammed funds from previous years and program income available for the 2014 program year is indicated below:
