<p>Details</p> <p>Reason for Legislation</p> <p>To estimate revenues of \$65,733 and appropriate same in the Police Grants Fund.</p> <p>This ordinance provides funds for cameras and related equipment to be installed near sixteen medium to high risk assets.</p> <p>Discussion (explain all financial aspects of the proposed legislation, including future implications, any direct/indirect costs, specific account numbers, ordinance references, and budget page numbers.)</p> <p>This ordinance applies to the Homeland Security Program.</p> <p>The Department of Homeland Security has awarded a grant to the Police Department to purchase and a camera system installed in helicopters that transmits visual images to ground stations with the objective to better secure potential targets from terrorism.</p> <p>The grant is 75% federally funded and the Police Department will provide the 25% match.</p>
