Reason for Legislation

Authorizing acceptance of a grant from the Department of Justice , Office on Violence Against Women, in the amount of \$300,000, estimating revenues and appropriations in the amount of \$300,000 to the Community Arrest Program Grant account in the Domestic Violence Shelter Operating Fund; and authorizing the Director of Neighborhoods and Housing Services to enter a contract with Rose Brooks Center in the amount of \$300,000.

Discussion (explain all financial aspects of the proposed legislation, including future implications, any direct/indirect costs, specific account numbers, ordinance references, and budget page numbers.)

On September 11, 2014, the Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, awarded the City \$300,000 in funding an existing grant, number 2014-WE-AX-0009.

The purpose of the grant is to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program (Community Arrest Program) and implements certain provisions of the Violence Against Women Act, which is enacted in September 1994 as Title IV of the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 and reauthorized in the Violence Against Women Act of 2000.

The program enhances victim safety and offender accountability in cases of domestic violence and dating violence by encouraging jurisdictions to implement mandatory and pro-arrest policies as an effective domestic violence intervention that is part of a coordinated community response. An integral component of Arrest Program initiative is the creation and enhancement of collaborative partnerships between criminal justice agencies, victim services providers and community organizations which respond to domestic violence.
