The HIV Services program provided HIV/AIDS services for 2,476 unduplicated clients during the period from March 2012 to February 2013. Funding for ambulatory and primary care services ensures that residents living with HIV/AIDS, within the KC TGA, receive appropriate health care services and treatment of their disease through federal and local funding.

### Is it good for the children?

Yes, these services are provided to children and youth living with HIV/AIDS. Last year, over 22% of clients served were women, youth, infants, and/or children.
