Public Management Interns rotate through the City Manager's Office, Office of Management and Budget and the Public Works Department in four-month increments. Interns are given considerable roles and responsibilities on assignments so that they are provided with a significant learning experience. Qualifications for the program include a Master's degree in Public Administration or similar discipline, and the submittal of undergraduate and graduate transcripts and a letter explaining the applicant's career goals. The City of Kansas City Missouri's Cookingham Public Management Intern program is sought out by many interested applicants as well as colleges and universities each year. This ordinance will allow the City Manager Department to pay Mr. Anthony Miller a sum not to exceed \$37,125.00 for his participation in the 2001-2002 Intern program. Mr. Miller is the only one of this year's interns who has a spouse and children and thereby the city's contribution to his health insurance causes his total cost to exceed \$35,000 necessitating City Council review.
