

ORDINANCE NO. 140737

Authorizing a Cooperative Agreement with Jackson County, Missouri, the City of Overland Park, Kansas and Loch Lloyd Country Club for the Kenneth Road Bridge Improvements project; estimating revenues in the amount of \$3,570,000.00 in the Capital Improvements Fund; appropriating that amount to the project account; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

WHEREAS, the Kenneth Road Bridge over Blue River (151st Street Bridge in Kansas) is located at the border of Missouri and Kansas at the western city limit of Kansas City, which is also the western limit of Jackson County and the eastern limit of Overland Park, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, Loch Lloyd Country Club owns properties adjacent to the Kenneth Road Bridge over Blue River; and

WHEREAS, the Kenneth Road Bridge over Blue River is in poor condition and is closed to traffic; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of all parties and the travelling public to replace Kenneth Road Bridge over Blue River and all parties have agreed to enter into an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement for the purpose of constructing the public improvement of Kenneth Road Bridge over Blue River; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the revenue in the following account of the Capital Improvements Fund is estimated in the following amount:

Section 2. That the sum of \$3,570,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Capital Improvements Fund to the following account in the Capital Improvements Fund:

Section 3. That the Director of Public Works is designated requisitioning authority for Account No. 15-3090-898036.

Section 4. That this ordinance, relating to the design, repair, maintenance or construction of a public improvement, is recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)(D) of the City Charter and shall take effect in accordance with Section 503, City Charter.
