Authorizing the condemning and taking of private property for Street Right of Way purposes, Storm Drainage Easements and Temporary Construction Easements, for the construction of Project Number 89008176, Douglas Street - Lee's Summit Road Improvements, in the area along and to the West of the shared municipal boundary of Lee's Summit and Kansas City from Gregory Boulevard to the said city limit, in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri; providing for the payment of just compensation therefore; authorizing continued negotiations by the Director of the Department of Public Works; consenting to the filing of the petition for condemnation by the City Attorney, on behalf of the City; and authorizing and directing the City Clerk to file this ordinance with the Recorder of Deeds in Jackson County, Missouri.

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the City of Kansas City, Missouri, with the adoption of Ordinance No. 080248 on March 20th, 2008, approved a recommendation of the Arterial Street Impact Fee Committee for District F and authorized the appropriation of funds from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Arterial Street Impact Fee Fund to the 08-2430-897533-B Lee's Summit Road-Gregory to City Limits account in the Arterial Street Impact Fee Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that the City of Kansas City, Missouri, with the adoption of Ordinance No. 100082 on February 4th, 2010, authorized the Director of Public Works to execute a cooperative agreement with the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri for the design of street improvements to Lee's Summit Road from Gregory South to the city limits of Lee's Summit; and

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that private property must be condemned for public use for street right of way required for the construction and maintenance of Lee's Summit Road and associated improved intersections, drive approaches and infrastructure in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the following described tracts of land are hereby condemned and taken for public use as Street Right of Way, Storm Drainage Easements, and Temporary Construction Easements for the construction of project 89008176, Douglas Street - Lee's

Summit Road Improvements, in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, and hereby described as follows:

Street Right of Way

Section 5. That just compensation for the property taken shall be assessed and paid according to law; and the proceedings to determine compensation shall be prosecuted in one or more suits in the Circuit Court of Jackson County, Missouri,

pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 523 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as supplemented or amended by Section 86.01 to 86.10 of the Rules of Civil Procedure. Payment of compensation shall be made by Kansas City from funds appropriated for such purposes.

Section 6. That pending the acquisition of said lands by condemnation, the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to negotiate the purchase of said land and pay for them out of funds appropriated or to be appropriated as aforesaid, and if any tracts be so acquired by negotiation and purchase, the City Attorney is authorized to withdraw same from condemnation proceedings.

Section 7. That said right of way be condemned and conveyed to Kansas City, Missouri, in fee simple.

Section 8. That upon the effective date of this ordinance, the City Clerk is hereby directed to record this ordinance in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Jackson County, Missouri.
