

ORDINANCE NO. 130794

Authorizing the City Manager to execute the third amendment of a contract with the Neighborhood Housing Services of Kansas City to extend the term and increase the total amount of the contract up to \$1,030,500.00, all to further the EnergyWorks KC program.

WHEREAS, the City was one of 41 entities nationwide selected by the Department of Energy (“DOE”) to be a recipient of a Better Buildings Program grant and the City has negotiated a revised scope of work consistent with a grant award in the amount of \$20,000,000.00 in order to implement the EnergyWorks KC (“EWKC”) program over a three-year period; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 110896, the City entered into Contract No. EECBG-ARRA-OEQ-8 (“Contract”) with Neighborhood Housing Services (“NHS”) to effectuate the EWKC program; and

WHEREAS, the contract has been amended on two previous occasions to account for extensions related to the grant award; and

WHEREAS, DOE has now extended the City’s grant term to March 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Contract with NHS to account for the extended programmatic year; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a third amendment to the Contract with the NHS to extend the term and increase the total contract amount up to \$1,030,500.00, all to further the EWKC program. A copy of the third amendment, approved in substantial form, is on file with the Office of Environmental Quality.

Section 2. That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to expend up to \$3,000.00 from previously appropriated funds in Account No. 14-2530-105056-B-G10EECBST to satisfy the cost of this amendment.
