

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ORDINANCE NO. 170141

Stating City Council's commitment to fund improvements to Missouri Route 1 and Parvin Road intersection in an amount up to \$700,000.00 and authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Cost Apportionment Agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation for the improvements.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Route 1 and Parvin Road is currently a four way stop which results in traffic delays for employees and emergency vehicles traveling to North Kansas City Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) has completed project scoping and determined that a single lane roundabout will improve traffic flow and travel times to North Kansas City Hospital and improve the intersection to urban standards and add pedestrian accommodations including crosswalks; and

WHEREAS, the City has completed a study of the Parvin Road corridor which called for adding bike lanes, a sidewalk on the south side, a multi-purpose trail on the north side, and upgrade of Parvin Road to boulevard standards with landscaping and street lighting; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of these improvements exceeds \$1.4M and MoDOT is willing to partner with the City to construct the roundabout and implement portions of the Parvin Road study; and

WHEREAS, MoDOT and the City have agreed to a Cost Apportionment Agreement that, subject to the appropriation of funds, will govern the partnership for these improvements; and

WHEREAS, with approval of this cost apportionment agreement, construction of the Improvements is anticipated to begin in 2019; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the City Council expresses its commitment to fund a share of the improvements to the intersection of Missouri Route 1 and Parvin Road in the amount of \$700,000.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Cost Apportionment Agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation for improvements to Missouri Route 1 and Parvin Road. A copy of the agreement is approved in substantial form and is on file in the Office of the City Manager.
