

ORDINANCE NO. 110199

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Tax Increment Financing Commission in the amount of \$300,000.00 for the construction of N.W. 88th Street; and authorizing the Director of Public Works to expend funds for the contract.

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 990256, the Council accepted the recommendations of the Tax Increment Financing Commission of Kansas City (“Commission”) and approved the KCI Corridor Tax Increment Financing Plan (the “Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Plan has been amended nine times with Ordinance Nos. 040618, 040619, 040620, 040621, 050107, 060326, 080211, 090260, and 101007; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the amendments, funding was identified for the design and construction of N.W. 88th Street between a point 118 feet east of N. Chatham Avenue and a point 676 feet east of N. Camden Court; and

WHEREAS; Committee Substitute for Ordinance No. 100692, As Amended, established the 2011 GO Bond Fund and appropriated funding for N.W. 88th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Commission and City wish to complete both projects cooperatively and in partnership; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to execute a cooperative funding agreement in the amount of \$300,000.00 with the Tax Increment Financing Commission for the purpose of providing for the construction of N.W. 88th Street between a point 118 feet east of N. Chatham Avenue and a point 676 feet east of N. Camden Court. The agreement is approved in substantial form as that on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, subject to the receipt of all required approvals.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to expend the sum of \$300,000.00 from funds previously appropriated to Account No. AL-3397-898201-B-89008223.
