Expressing support for pursuing the Department of Transportation's "Beyond Traffic" Grant Opportunity; and directing the City Manager to submit the appropriate grant application.

- improves the areas of urban analytics, user-focused mobility services and choices, urban delivery and logistics, strategic business models, and engages connected and involved citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Council understands the importance of developing and innovating the City's transportation infrastructure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Council express their support for all efforts toward the pursuit of the "Beyond Traffic" grant award of \$50 million from the Department of Transportation.
